**SPONSOR STATEMENT**

**House Bill 161**

**Purchase of Used Durable Medical Equipment  
Version H**

House Bill 161 is a cost saving bill for the state's medical assistance programs. Currently the Department of Health and Social Services only purchases new Durable Medical Equipment, even though used Durable Medical Equipment is available and is able to withstand repeated use.

House Bill 161 says that, "When the department authorizes the purchase of durable medical equipment, the department may require a recipient of medical assistance services to purchase used or refurbished durable medical equipment if used or refurbished durable medical equipment is available, is less expensive, including shipping, than new durable medical equipment of the same type, is able to withstand at least three years of use and equally meets the needs of the recipient."
