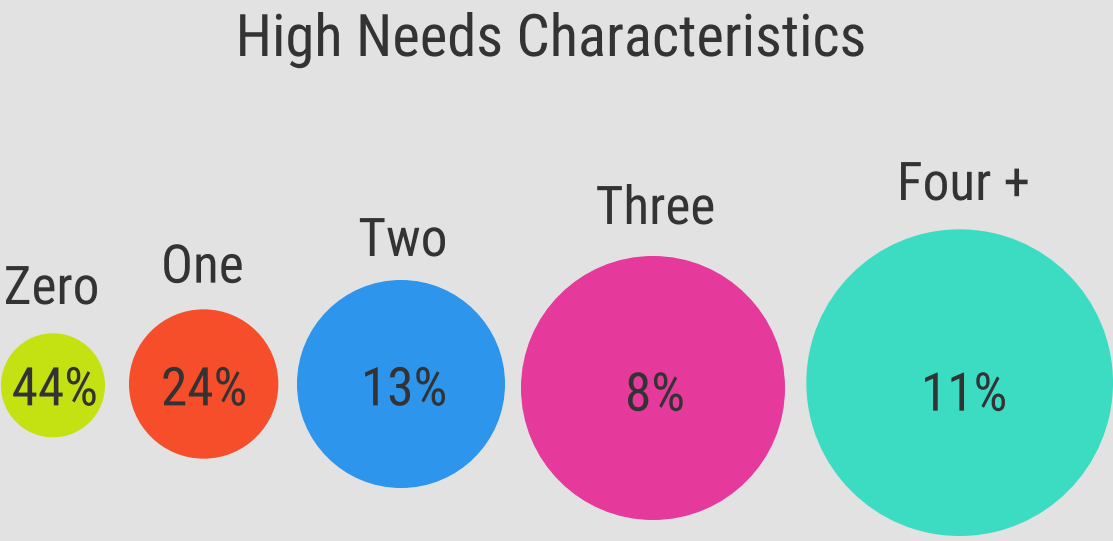
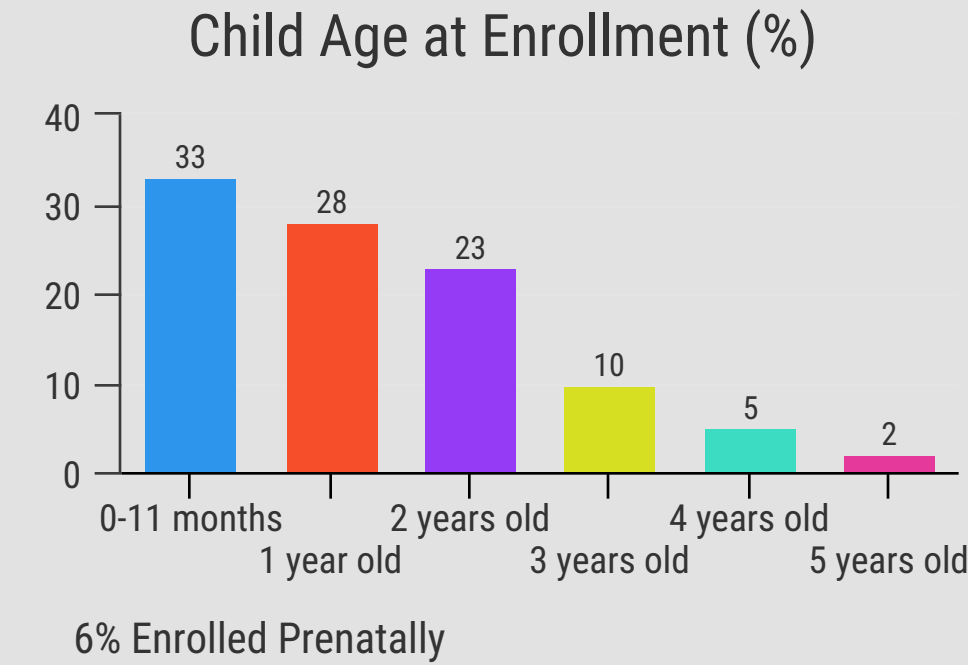
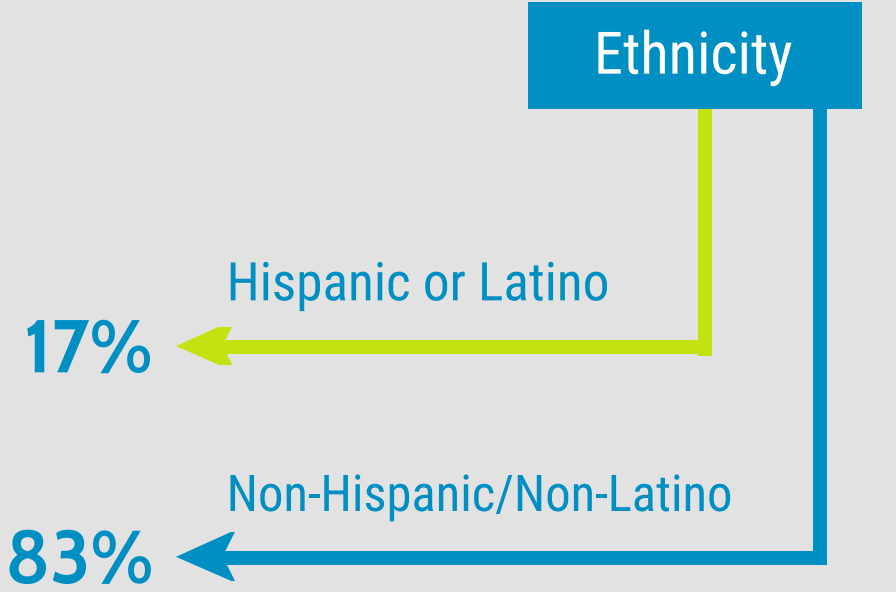
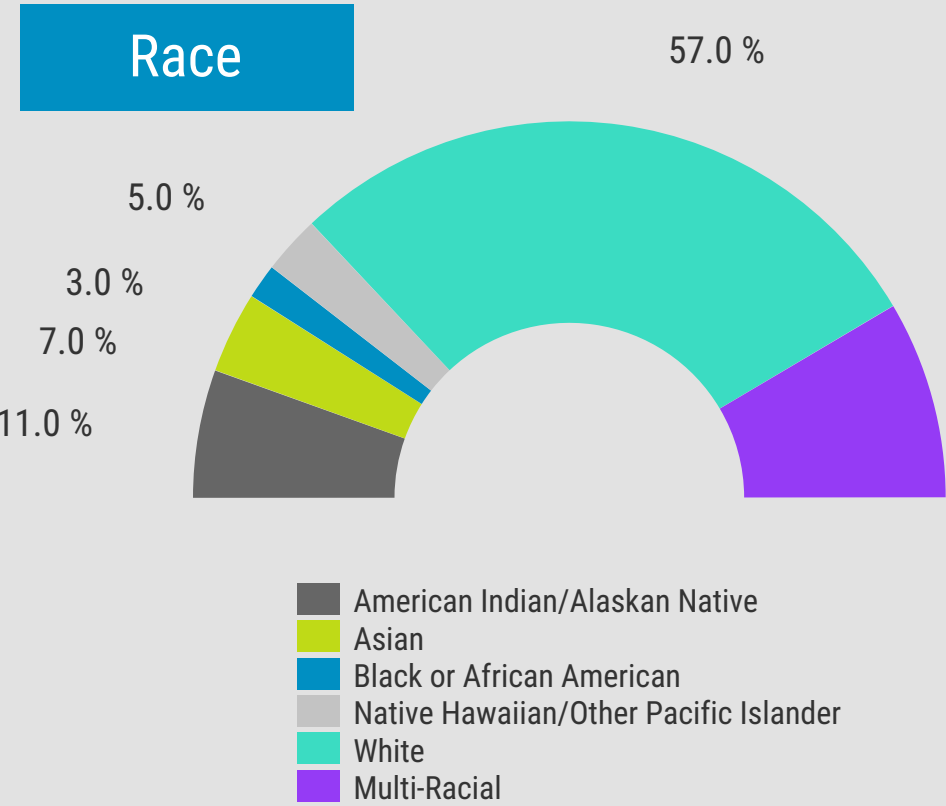
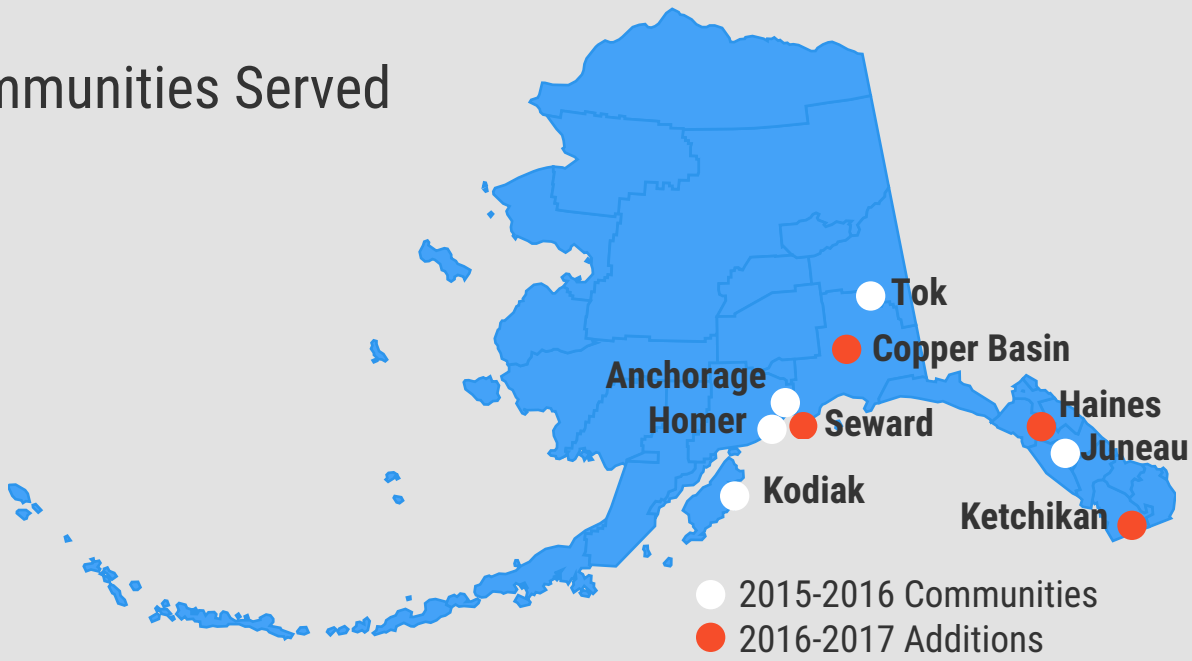
Parents as Teachers™

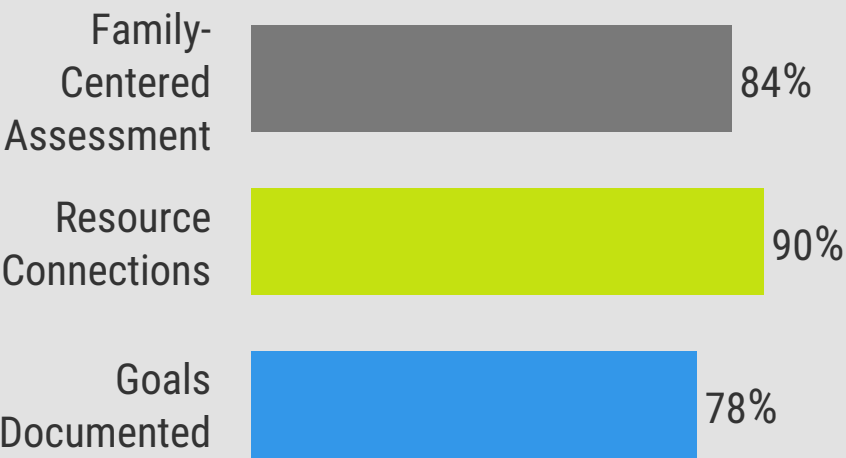

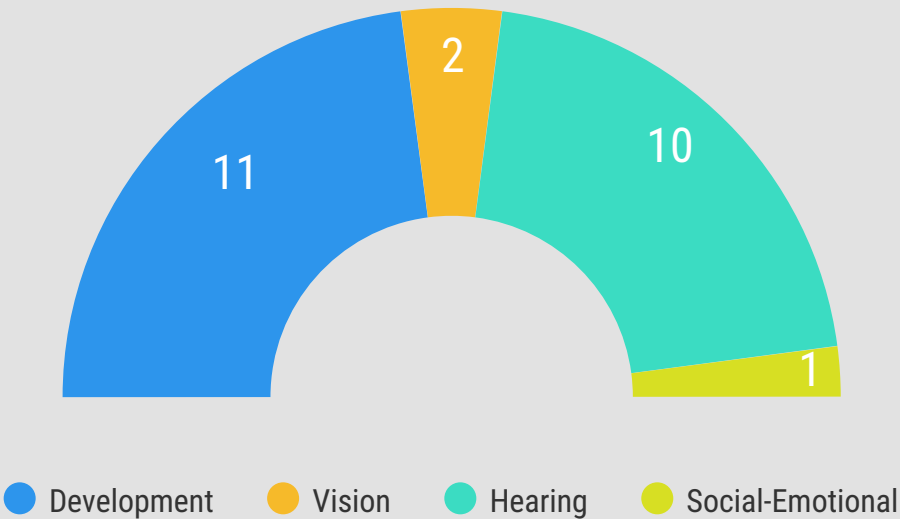

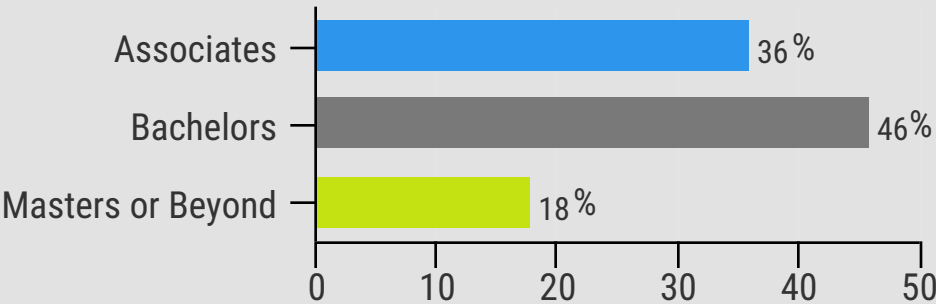

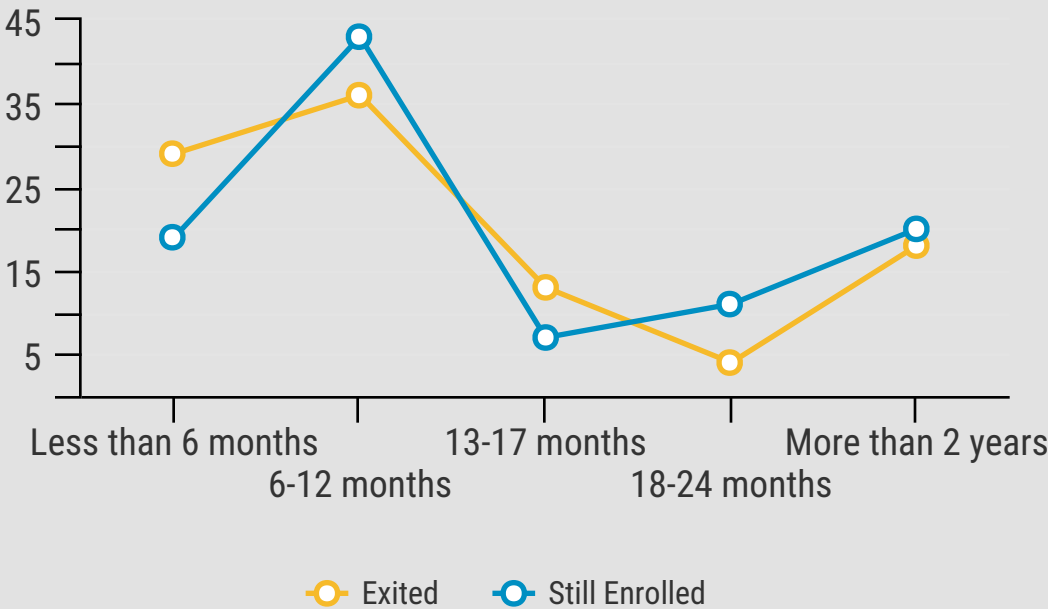
