- 1 "An Act relating to collecting information about civil litigation by the Alaska Judicial
- 2 Council; repealing Rule 41(a)(3), Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, and Rules 511(c) and
- 3 (e), Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure; and providing for an effective date."
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * Section 1. Rule 41(a)(3), Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, and Rules 511(c) and (e),
- 6 Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure, are repealed.
- 7 * **Sec. 2.** AS 09.68.130 is repealed.
- * Sec. 3. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
- 9 read:
- 10 CONDITIONAL EFFECT. This Act takes effect only if sec. 1 of this Act receives the
- 11 two-thirds majority vote of each house required by art. IV, sec. 15, Constitution of the State of
- 12 Alaska.
- * Sec. 4. If this Act takes effect under sec. 3 of this Act, it takes effect immediately under
- 14 AS 01.10.070(c).
