## Summary of Changes | HB 81 – More Energy Efficient Buildings Act

**Amendment 1**: Explicitly adds regional native housing authorities to the bill. Offered in House Energy on January 31st.

**Amendment 2:** Clarifies that electric co-ops, which are 501 c (12) non-profit organizations, cannot receive energy efficiency loans that relate to power production and distribution. They can request energy efficiency loans that would be used their building structures and non-power related infrastructure, as loans would be used by other non-profits. Offered in House Energy on February 7th.
