## **3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* Section 1. AS 44.23.020(e) is amended to read:

(e) There is established within the Department of Law the function of public
advocacy for regulatory affairs. The attorney general shall participate as a party in a
matter that comes before the Regulatory Commission of Alaska or the Federal
<u>Energy Regulatory Commission</u> when the attorney general determines that
participation is in the public interest. When considering whether participation is in the
public interest, the attorney general shall consider the issues the Regulatory
Commission of Alaska must take into consideration under AS 42.05.141(d).
