The Southeast Alaska Regional Dive Fisheries Association (SARDFA) appreciates your efforts to assist the emerging mariculture industry in Alaska. SARDFA has been involved in sea cucumber enhancement work for several years and relies on hatcheries to pilot research on hatchery spawning techniques for sea cucumbers. Without viable hatchery facilities in Alaska, we would not be able to do enhancement work of any kind.

Running hatcheries is costly and at times there are funding shortfalls that could affect many different mariculture related projects. By adapting the mariculture revolving loan fund to allow for hatcheries to receive funds will help stabilize Alaska’s mariculture industry.
