Requirements: Legislative Confirmation

Prohibitions: Members cannot serve more than all or part of two consecutive terms. Public members can have no direct financial interest in the health care industry.

Term: 4 years

Chair: Governor may select.

Description: The board consists of 5 members appointed by Governor: 3 licensed psychologists, 1 licensed psychological associate and 1 public member with no direct financial interest in health care industry.

Function: The board regulates and controls applications, licenses, and permits for the practice of psychology.

Special facts: Members serve at the pleasure of the Governor until a successor is appointed. An appointment to fill a vacancy is for the remainder of the unexpired term. A member who has served all or part of two successive terms may not be reappointed unless four years have elapsed since the person has last served.

Compensation: Standard Travel and Per Diem No additional compensation

Meetings: Quarterly, typically for six days out of the year.
