Dear Chair Giessel, Vice-Chair Coghill, and members of the Senate Resources committee,

Resident Hunters of Alaska (RHAK) strongly **<u>supports</u>** the appointment and confirmation of Tom Lamal to the Alaska Board of Game.

Mr. Lamal has long had an interest in hunting and wildlife conservation in Alaska, and has served on the Fairbanks Fish & Game Advisory Committee and on several boards of hunting conservation and advocacy organizations, including the Ruffed Grouse Society, Alaska Outdoor Council, and Resident Hunters of Alaska. (Note: Mr. Lamal resigned from the RHAK board when he was informed he was appointed to the Board of Game earlier this year.)
