#### BILL NO. HB 125

#### Analysis

HB 125 amends AS 18.65.310(I) and AS 28.15.111(c) and requires DMV to provide a veteran designator and United States flag replica on a driver's license or identification card of Hmong or Lao veterans that request the designator and meet the eligibility requirements. DMV will work with the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs to determine what type of proof is needed to verify eligibility.

DMV may not charge an addition fee to add the designator, but may charge \$5 to replace a valid license or ID card that doesn't currently have the designator with one that does.

DMV can provide these services for minimal additional resources, therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted.
