This area is a favorite recreation place for our community and a lot of people who live outside it. On any weekend in the summer it is packed with people camping, hiking, four wheeling, swimming, fishing, and shooting. That sounds fun until you see what actually goes on. Four wheelers are driving through camping spots and on roads at all hours of the day and night. There are no public bathrooms. Shooting is in all directions, and even toward housing areas; at all hours of the day and night. The noise is unbearable for residents and last year a man was accidentally shot and killed. The area looks like a war zone at the end of it. Trash and shell casings are everywhere. Our community needs your help to approve the legislation that makes it possible for rules and designated areas for certain activities. Please support SB65.
