FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 206

Analysis

HB 206 provides an exemption from Construction Licensing (under AS 08.18) for one or more contracts under \$10.0 for telecommunications, broadcast transmission, and video services installers.

HB 206 also provides an exemption from the Electrical Administrator requirement enumerated under AS 08.40 for “low voltage” work on telecommunications, broadcast transmission, and video services. Low voltage is defined as “56 volts or less.”

The Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
