1	Page 1, line 4, following "fund;":
2	Insert "relating to the duties of the Department of Revenue;"
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4	Page 2, following line 20:
5	Insert a new bill section to read:
6	"* Sec. 2. AS 43.23.055 is amended to read:
7	Sec. 43.23.055. Duties of the department. The department shall
8	(1) annually pay permanent fund dividends from the dividend fund;
9	(2) subject to AS 43.23.011 and [PARAGRAPH] (8) of this section,
10	adopt regulations under AS 44.62 (Administrative Procedure Act) that establish
11	procedures and time limits for claiming a permanent fund dividend; the department
12	shall determine the number of eligible applicants by October 1 of the year for which
13	the dividend is declared and pay the dividends by December 31 of that year;
14	(3) adopt regulations under AS 44.62 (Administrative Procedure Act)
15	that establish procedures and time limits for an individual upon emancipation or upon
16	reaching majority to apply for permanent fund dividends not received during minority
17	because the parent, guardian, or other authorized representative did not apply on
18	behalf of the individual;
19	(4) assist residents of the state, particularly in rural areas, who, because
20	of language, disability, or inaccessibility to public transportation, need assistance to
21	establish eligibility and to apply for permanent fund dividends;
22	(5) use a list of individuals ineligible for a dividend under
23	AS 43.23.005(d) provided annually by the Department of Corrections and the

1	Department of Public Safety to determine the number and identity of those
2	individuals;
3	(6) adopt regulations that are necessary to implement AS 43.23.005(d);
4	(7) adopt regulations that establish procedures for the parent, guardian,
5	or other authorized representative of a disabled individual to apply for prior year
6	permanent fund dividends not received by the disabled individual because no
7	application was submitted on behalf of the individual;
8	(8) adopt regulations that establish procedures for an individual to
9	apply to have a dividend disbursement under AS 37.25.050(a)(2) reissued if it is not
10	collected within two years after the date of its issuance; however, the department may
11	not establish a time limit within which an application to have a disbursement reissued
12	must be filed;
13	(9) provide any information, upon request, contained in permanent
14	fund dividend records to the child support services agency created in AS 25.27.010, or
15	the child support enforcement agency of another state, for child support purposes
16	authorized under law; if the information is contained in an electronic data base, the
17	department shall provide the requesting agency with either
18	(A) access to the data base; or
19	(B) a copy of the information in the data base and a statement
20	certifying its contents;
21	(10) establish a fraud investigation unit for the purpose of assisting the
22	(A) Department of Law in the prosecution of individuals who
23	apply for or obtain a permanent fund dividend in violation of a provision in
24	AS 11, by detecting and investigating those crimes; and
25	(B) commissioner to detect and investigate the claiming or
26	paying of permanent fund dividends that should not have been claimed by or
27	paid to an individual and to impose the penalties and enforcement provisions
28	under AS 43.23.035 <u>:</u>
29	(11) adopt regulations under AS 44.62 (Administrative Procedure
30	Act) so that contributions under AS 43.23.062 are given a priority over donations
31	under AS 43.23.064 if the total amount of contributions and donations elected by

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1	an applicant exceeds the amount of the permanent fund dividend that the
2	applicant is entitled to receive."
