FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2017 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

SB100 clarifies the current definition of "nonconsensual common law lien" to include liens provided for by municipal ordinance(s). The current definition only expressly includes "state or federal statute" and contains no reference to municipal ordinances.

SB100 also amends AS 29.35.010 by adding sub-section (17), which provides local governments the specific power to file liens on real or personal property for debts other than taxes as noted in sub-section (6) of the statute. Sub-section (17) also provides for the prioritization of liens that are filed or created under this revision to the statute.

The Division of Community and Regional Affairs does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this legislation.
