

Summary of Changes between Governor's Operating Bill & CSHB57 (FIN)

Numbers (Sections 1 – 3)

1. Amounts and fund sources are exactly the same as the Governor's bill
2. Fund groups and roll ups (in sections 2 & 3) will differ with the re-categorization of Permanent Fund fund codes

Language

3. Section 6(b) – corrected date from June 30, 2017 to June 30, 2018
4. Section 7 – Reordered the sections to
 - a. (a) appropriate the dedicated portion of revenue to the Permanent Fund
 - b. (b) FY18 appropriation to the Alaska Capital Income Fund
 - c. (c) FY17 appropriation to the general fund from the Earnings Reserve Account
 - d. (d) FY18 appropriation to the general fund from the Earnings Reserve Account
 - e. (e) backstop language to restrict appropriation from Earnings Reserve Account if oil prices rebound
 - f. (f) appropriation from the general fund to the dividend fund to pay dividends
5. Section 8(b) – corrected date from June 30, 2017 to June 30, 2018
6. Section 10 (g) and (h) – reordered to have the FY17-FY18 appropriation first and FY18-FY19 appropriation second
7. Section 19(i) – moved lapse extension appropriation within Debt and Other Obligations
8. Section 21(b) – corrected date from June 30, 2017 to June 30, 2018
9. Section 21(f) – moved Oil & Gas Tax appropriation within Fund Capitalizations
10. Section 21(g), (h) & (i) – moved Public Education Fund appropriations within Fund Capitalizations
11. Section 21(j) – moved REAA appropriation within Fund Capitalizations
12. Section 21(o) & (p) – moved Crime Victim Compensation Fund appropriations within Fund Capitalizations
13. Section 22(b) – corrected date from June 30, 2017 to June 30, 2018
14. Section 22(e) – moved Vaccine Assessment Account appropriation within Fund Transfers
15. Section 22(h) – moved Aviation fuel tax account appropriation within Fund Transfers
16. Section 23(g) – moved Judicial Retirement System appropriation within Retirement System Funding
17. Section 25(b) – corrected date from June 30, 2017 to June 30, 2018
