Natasha Alexenko and I are contacting you in support of your bill (HB 31) to establish a rape kit tracking system for Alaska, along with other rape kit reform. In the meantime, you may be interested in learning about the federal grant called SAFE-ITR (Sexual Assault Forensic Exam – Inventory, Tracking, Reporting) which can be used to establish rape kit tracking systems. Of course, state-based funding is always best, but...the federal grant could help with fiscal note considerations.
