Explanation of Changes

House Bill 265 – An Act relating to the removal of a license involving alcoholic beverages; and relating to the issuance, renewal, or transfer of ownership of a beverage dispensary license or a restaurant or eating place license.”

Changes from version A to Sponsor Substitute version D

Section 1 – No Changes

Section 2 –

In version D – AS 04.11.400 (a) is amended to include a reference to new sub-section (o) on Page 2, line 20 and Page 3, Line 9

Section 3 – (Formerly Section 2 in Version A)

Deletes and inserts language necessary for the addition of grandfather language for licenses under this section, to reflect the addition of sub-section (o).

Section 4 – Inserts new Sub-section (o) to AS 04.11.400

This section is new statutes to allow for the review of the required rental rooms based on population for the issuance of a tourism related liquor license only at the time of the initial issuance of a license. This will grandfather in existing license holders under this section to the number of rental rooms that were required at the time of initial issuance. This section will apply at the time of renewal, transfer, or change in ownership of the tourism based liquor license.
