

University of Alaska Impacts of \$8 million FY18 Budget Reductions

UAA

- 146 fewer course sections
- Reduced academic, administrative (HR, IT Financial Services, Facilities & Campus Services) and student services
- Delayed admission decision response time
- Increased charges for services and facility use
- Ended the Great Alaska Shootout

UAF

- Scholarship/fellowship graduate aid reductions
- Reduction in number of graduate teaching assistants
- Closed two residence halls
- Increased service fees
- Reduced athletic funding/scholarships
- Reduced KUAC memberships, eliminating some programming, and delayed replacement of aging equipment
- Consolidated rural student bookstore operations with Fairbanks Campus contracted bookstore operations
- Closed Unalakaleet Learning Center
- Consolidated research building operating & computing support
- Left most vacated tenure-track faculty positions unfilled, or replaced with term instructors or adjuncts
- Reduced research capacity (due to loss of faculty positions)
- Eliminated support for grant management software
- Eliminated Siemens energy monitoring services (in-house)

UAS

- Consolidated management and Arts & Sciences schools
- Reduced library collections
- Reduced access to electronic subscriptions
- Reduced hours of service for student support areas
- Delayed replacement of classroom and office technologies
- Added course reinstatement fee
