RE: Beverage Dispensary - Tourism Licenses Report - Revised

Requested Action: Move to support a statutory change to grandfather licenses that were originally compliant with the number of rental rooms

Statutory Authority: N/A
Staff Recommendation: Support a statutory change
Background: On July 20, 2016, the board voted unanimously to open a regulations project "to clarify some of the parameters around AS 04.11.400(d) tourism licenses." On October 26, 2016, Director Franklin asked the board for guidance regarding what it is looking for for tourism license parameters. The chair requested that staff provide data on the number of tourism licenses that do not meet current room requirements set forth in AS 04.11.400(d)(1).

In September I reported to the board that 34 BDL-tourism licenses did not meet the statutory requirements of AS $04.11 .400(\mathrm{~d})(1)$, and that nine licenses were questionable. The board requested that we do more analysis of the 43 licenses to determine whether they met statutory requirements at the time they were first issued.

It is important to note that this section of statute changed in 1985. Prior to June 6, 1985, the requirement was simply to have 10 hotel rooms. Beginning June 6,1985 , the requirement changed ${ }^{1}$ to our current statutory language:
(1) a hotel, motel, resort, or similar business relating to the tourist trade with a dining facility or having kitchen facilities in a majority of its rental rooms and at least a minimum number of rental rooms required according to the population of the established village, incorporated city, unified municipality or population area established under AS 04.11 .400 (a) in which the facility will be located, as follows:
(A) 10 rental rooms if the population is less than 1,501 ;
(B) 20 rental rooms if the population is between 1,501 and 2,500 ;
(C) 25 rental rooms if the population is between 2,501 and 5,000 ;

[^0](D) 30 rental rooms if the population is between 5,001 and 15,000 ;
(E) 35 rental rooms if the population is between 15,001 and 25,000 ;
(F) 40 rental rooms if the population is between 25,001 and 50,000 ; and
(G) 50 rental rooms if the population is greater than 50,000 ; or
(2) an airport terminal.

The 34 licenses we reported as noncompliant fall into four categories (see attachment):

- 2 licenses were determined to be compliant
- 26 licenses were compliant (or likely compliant) at the time of issuance. Of those, 23 were issued prior to June 6, 1985, the date the rental room requirement was increased.
- 2 licenses do not contain enough information in the onsite files to determine when the license was first issued. However, given the license numbers, it is likely they were first issued prior to 1985, which would make them compliant at time of issuance.
- 4 licenses appear to not have been issued in compliance with statute

Of the nine licenses that were reported as questionable (see attachment), additional research has shown that:

- 6 licenses appear to be in compliance
- 1 license appears to have been issued without sufficient number of rental rooms
- 2 licenses are questionable as to their dining facilities

Statute does not provide for grandfathering licenses that were compliant at the time of issuance but that were transferred when out of compliance with the rental room requirement of AS 04.11.400(d). Staff thoroughly examined statute to determine whether another solution could be found, but we were unsuccessful.

Revocation of over 34 licenses, in the opinion of staff, is not in the best interest of the public and the communities in which these licenses are located. We suggest that a legislative solution be pursued for those licenses that were compliant at the time they were first issued.

All BDL - Tourism licenses will continue to be brought before the board for renewal. At renewal time, the board can determine how to address non-compliant licensees.
