## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

### Analysis

This bill prohibits the procurement of internet services from providers who do not follow “net neutrality” principles. State solicitations and contracts will need to include language stipulating this requirement. Current Internet Service Providers under contract with the State are already following net neutrality principles. The Department of Administration, Shared Services of Alaska Division, anticipates minimal effects as a result of this legislation; therefore, the agency submits a zero fiscal note.
