FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2017 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

SB 80 updates AS 42.05.296, which authorizes telephone services to deaf, hard of hearing, and speech impaired consumers only in the manner those services were provided and paid for in 1970. SB 80 provides the Regulatory Commission of Alaska with authority to expand the type of telecommunication devices and software available to the deaf, hard of hearing, and speech disabled.
It is anticipated that regulations directed by SB 80 would be adopted within the time allowed by AS 42.05.175(e), within 730 days after a rule-making proceeding is opened.
The Regulatory Commission of Alaska does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
