
#### Alaska Division of Public Health

# Division of Public Health Funding Sources FY2019 Governor's Budget



 Public health lacks fee authority for other services and functions:

- Professional services
  - Data extraction and analysis
  - Training and expert consultation
- Administrative functions
  - Inspections and certifications
  - Program administration



- Fees waived if
  - not in the public interest
  - not economically feasible to collect
  - the public health is best served by the waiver of the fee
- Services not denied because of inability to pay
- Sliding fee schedules
- Fees limited to the actual cost
- Regulations required for each new fee
