SUBJECT: Legislative Council Travel & Per Diem Policy

Per AS 24.10.130 Legislative Council sets the travel and per diem policy. Currently, session per diem is paid at the federal rate, which is set by the Department of Defense and fluctuates due to changes in season and cost of living increases. During the 30<sup>th</sup> Legislature, the per diem rate increased by 23% from \$213 to \$275 per day.

On September 1, 2018, the daily rate increased again to \$302, which would be in effect for the 31<sup>st</sup> Legislature. As many of you are aware, Legislative Council set per diem at a flat rate of \$275 for the Second Session of the 30<sup>th</sup> Legislature only, so if Council takes no action prior to the 31<sup>st</sup> Legislature, the rate will be \$302 per day. The FY19 budget is based on a session per diem rate of \$275.

I propose setting a flat per diem rate for all legislative sessions (regular, extended, and special); with consideration of the following options:

Option 1 - \$213 per day (30th Legislature original rate)

Option 2 - \$263 per day (average of \$213, \$275, and \$302)

Option 3 - \$275 per day (FY19 budgeted per diem rate)
