3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

5 Sec. 44.12.150. Indigenous Peoples Day. Indigenous Peoples Day is 6 established on the second Monday of October of each year. Indigenous Peoples Day 7 may be observed by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
