Page 1, line 1, following "ballots":

Insert "**and the prohibition on political persuasion near election polls**"

Page 1, following line 2:

Insert a new bill section to read:

"* **Section 1.** AS 15.15.170 is amended to read:

Sec. 15.15.170. Prohibition of political persuasion near election polls. (a)

During the hours the polls are open, a person who is in the polling place or within 200 feet of any entrance to the polling place may not

(1) attempt to persuade a person to vote for or against a candidate, proposition, or question; **or**

(2) physically display a photo, video, or other image of the person's marked ballot in an attempt to persuade a person to vote for or against a candidate, proposition, or question.

(b) The election officials shall post warning notices at the required distance in the form and manner prescribed by the director."

Delete "**Section 1**"

Insert "**Sec. 2**"

Renumber the following bill section accordingly.
