STATE OF ALASKA 2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill increases sentencing ranges and terms of probation, removes the provisions automatically adjusting theft thresholds for inflation, creates some new crimes, and increases the penalties for others.						
The Public Defender Agency anticipates an increase in workload and increasing costs for the Agency related to the litigation of these cases. The Agency cannot accurately predict the extent of the fiscal impact of this legislation. Therefore, the agency submits an indeterminate fiscal note.						

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
