#### **ASD: The Road to Recovery**




The Road to Recovery: ASD Returns to the Mission of "Educating all Students for Success in Life."

Since the 7.0 earthquake at 8:29AM on Friday morning, November 30, ASD has been assessing all 92 facilities, including more than 4,000 classroom learning spaces. 

#### Details:

- 1. 7 of 15 schools in the Chugiak–Eagle River area
- 2. Architecture & Engineer (A&E) firms conducting structural and architectural assessments
- Time line: Draft Project Analysis Reports (PAR) due to the District in February; final reports in March
- 4. FEMA/SOA DHS-EM verification of requirements/updates beginning February 4<sup>th</sup>

# Post Earthquake: Costs (initial)

- \$22.39 million in commitments (open contracts plus items that have been ordered but haven't arrived).
- **\$5.09 million** toward invoices for repair parts received/installed.
- These costs are for the initial contracts that were let between 30 November and the end of December.
- These costs do not include the top 15 schools that are currently being evaluated by architecture and design firms.
