Analysis

This bill amends AS 11.41.200, assault in the first degree, by adding a new subsection to specifically address the act of strangulation; amends AS 11.41.425, sexual assault in the third degree and AS 11.41.438, sexual abuse of a minor in the third degree, by adding new subsections to include certain sex acts as elements of those offenses; and amends the definition of "dangerous instrument" under AS 11.81.900(b)(15)(B) to include "other body parts" in addition to hands or other objects.

Passage of this bill is not expected to have a significant impact on the enforcement efforts of the Alaska State Troopers. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is being submitted.
