## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

### Analysis

This legislation will have zero fiscal impact on the Parole Board. The applicable sections of the bill relate to parole eligibility. The bill directs that inmates serving time for crimes for which they may not earn statutory good time cannot be eligible for discretionary parole. This change will reduce the number of hearings before the Parole Board by approximately ten per year which is not enough to substantially impact the Parole Board's workload.
