Summary of Changes ver A to ver M | HB 83

Section 1 of version M is updated to specify that the division can deliver absentee ballots to voters by fax, but voters are prohibited from returning completed absentee ballots to the division by fax.

Section 2 of version A relates to how a voter can apply for an absentee ballot, whereas version M does not include any language that would affect how a voter can apply for an absentee ballot.

Section 2 of version M repeals a provision that relates to the return of absentee ballots by electronic transmission (such as fax).
