## State Funding and Alaska Public Broadcasting Entities

Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission (APBC): Distributes state funding in the form of operating grants for local stations. Statutorily mandated.

Alaska Public Broadcasting Incorporated (APBI): Private non-profit working to provide coordination, administrative, engineering and technical support to local stations.

Alaska Rural Communication Services (ARCS)- State owned, managed by APBI, provides content, carrier services, and emergency communication services to rural communities and stations through satellite technology.

## Where does AKPM fit in?

Alaska Public Media (AKPM)- Local station based in Anchorage, provides statewide news content like Alaska News Nightly. Formerly Alaska Public Radio Network (APRN) and Alaska Public Television.

## But what about CPB?

Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB)- Federal agency granting funding directly to local stations, not a content creator. No state money flows through CPB.
