A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to a license to drive a commercial motor vehicle."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.33.100(a) is amended to read:
(a) A person may not drive a commercial motor vehicle until the person
applies for and is issued a license for that purpose under AS 28.15.041. The
department may not issue a license to drive a commercial motor vehicle unless the
applicant
(1) is at least $\underline{18}$ [19] years of age, to operate in intrastate commerce, or
at least 21 years of age, to operate in interstate commerce, except as provided in (f)
of this section;
(2) has held a valid driver's license at least one year before the date of
application or meets the experience qualifications established by the department;
(3) has successfully completed all required driving tests and written
and physical examinations;
(4) either does not have a driver's license issued by another jurisdiction

1	or surrenders all driver's licenses issued by other jurisdictions; and
2	(5) is domiciled in this state.

4	(f) The department may authorize a person who is at least 18 years of age but
5	under 21 years of age to operate a commercial vehicle in interstate commerce if the
6	person
7	(1) holds a valid commercial driver's license under (a) of this section;

9	(2) is authorized to operate a commercial vehicle in interstate
10	commerce under federal law.
