Analysis

This bill adds language expanding the definition of assault in the first degree to include causing someone to become unconscious with a dangerous instrument (including hands and other body parts). The department has an average of 113 inmates incarcerated for assault in the first degree each year. The average length of stay for assault in the first degree is 1,611 days (4.4 years). The department projects an increase in inmates as a result of this change: year 1 has no projected increase; year 2 an increase of 2.83 inmates with a cost of \$174.3; year 3 and subsequent years an increase of 5.66 inmates with a cost of \$348.6 for each year.
This bill adds language that makes causing someone to become unconscious by means of a dangerous instrument as an aggravator for assault in the first degree allowing sentences above the presumptive range. The department has an average of 113 inmates incarcerated for assault in the first degree each year. The average length of stay for assault in the first degree is 1,611 days (4.4 years). The department projects five percent (5.66 offenders) of assault in the first degree inmates will be convicted under this presumptive sentence adjustment and projects an average increase of one year of incarceration as a result of this change: years 1-4 have no projected increase; year 5 an increase of 2.27 inmates with a cost of \$139.8; year 6 an increase of 5.66 inmates with a cost of \$348.6 for each year.
