## **Analysis**

The Commercial Fisheries Division intends to utilize existing staff under the Aquaculture Section to administer program proposed in this legislation. The Private Nonprofit Hatchery Permit Coordinator is the primary person for evaluating these permit applications. Department of Fish and Game genetics, pathology, and management contribute to the permit application review process. Permit application review generally takes six months to complete. The Department of Fish and Game considers these additional operating expenditures to be indeter because there are several variables that could potentially change the cost to the Department. The permit fee is established in AS 16.012.010(c) at \$1,000. This fee would also apply to applications for new private nonprofit hatcheries, which is currently \$100. Based on industry interest, the division anticipates that be two or three applications per year for the first two years and then decline to an estimated one permit apply year.
