FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation merges the Division of Labor Standards and Safety and the Division of Workers' Compensation into the Division of Workers' Safety and Compensation. The new division would administer the same programs as are currently administered by the two separate divisions. The department's regulations need to be updated to reflect the division name change.
This merger will not result in an immediate cost savings within Workers' Compensation. Potential future year cost savings will have to be determined as position responsibilities and lease space needs are evaluated moving forward.

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
