- 1 "An Act establishing the month of February as Black History Month."
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:
- Sec. 44.12.180. Black History Month. The month of February each year is established as Black History Month. Black History Month may be observed by schools, community groups, and other public and private agencies and individuals with appropriate activities to honor and recognize the contributions that African Americans have made in the history of this state and the United States.
