FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

There is a companion fiscal notes for this bill the Medicaid Services component that projects increased costs without the Certificate of Need Program.

The certificate of need process requires health service providers to obtain approval of the commissioner before building or remodeling health care facilities, or purchasing equipment costing more than an established capital expenditure threshold. Under AS 18.07.031, the existing expenditure threshold for requiring a certificate of need is \$1,500.0. Alaska is one of 31 states and the District of Columbia to have a Certificate of Need program.

SB001 would repeal the Certificate of Need Program, effective July 1, 2020 (start of FY2021). The passage of this bill, will result in one position deletion (Medical Program Specialist IV), for an annual total cost savings of \$147.6. There will also be an additional annual cost savings of \$29.4 in contractual services and \$2.0 saved in commodities. The total projected savings is \$179.0.
