Amendments to House Bill 12:

K.3: For Sec. 1 - A court may not deny a request for a protective order solely because a victim is not in a position to confront their abuser or their abuser's lawyer in person.

K.4: For Sec. 1 - In addition to the amendment above, protection against denial is also extended to situations in which the crime for which a previous protective order was issued was not the sole reason for granting the protective order.

K.5: Applies the protections in the amendments above uniformly for all protective orders.

K.6: In addition to the amendments above, a court may not deny a request for a protective order solely because of where an abuser is currently believed to be.
