Definition of a teacher from the Certified Staff Accounting Handbook:

#### **15 Teacher**

“Use for general education teachers only. Use Job Code 21 for Special Education teachers and Job Code 31 for ESL (English as a Second Language) teachers. This job description instructs students in activities designed to promote intellectual, social and physical growth. Prepares outline for course of study, assigns and corrects assignments and tests; Records learning process; Maintains order in classroom; Discusses students’ progress with parents; May sponsor extracurricular activities. Use this general job description to cover all subjects and grade levels.”
