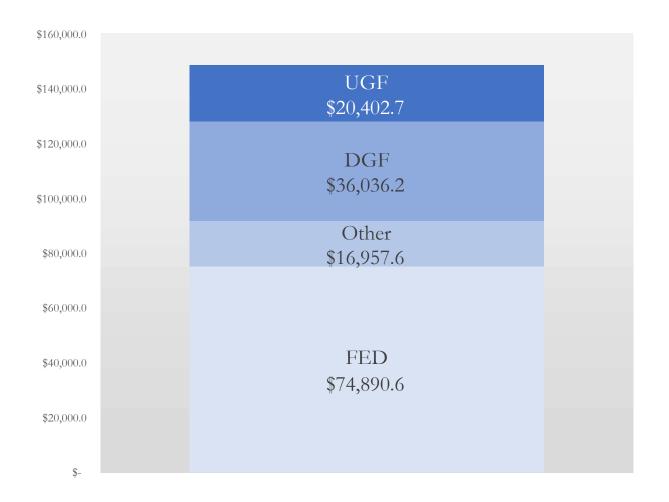

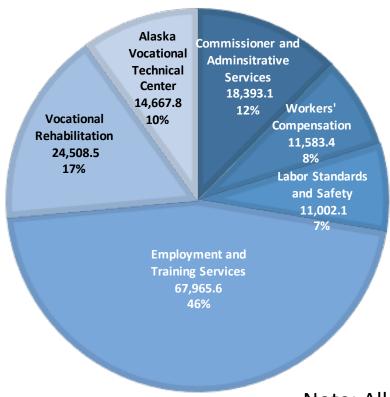

FY2020 Governor's Amended Total: \$148,287.1



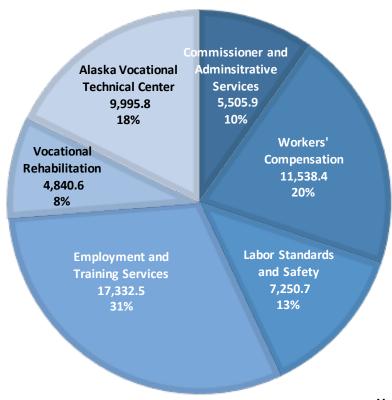


DOLWD FY2020 Governor's Amended Budget: FY2019 Comparison GF Only

 - Eliminate duplication

- AVTEC Net Zero (+/-\$267.1 GF)
 - Reduce dependency
 - Eliminate duplication

- AVTEC Student Supply Fees (+\$100.0 GF)
 - User Pay

DOLWD FY2020 Governor's Amended Budget: Legislation/Admin Changes

- Business process realignment
 - Procurement Consolidation Administrative Order (AO) 304
 - HR Consolidation AO 305
 - Investigator Consolidation AO 306
 - Workers' Compensation and Labor Standards and Safety Division Consolidation – HB 68 & SB 66
- Maximizing return on assets/investments
 - Oversight of Career and Technical Education Programs HB 67 & SB 65



DOLWD FY2020 Budget: House Finance Changes

- Three Governor's Amended travel reductions in Labor Standards and Safety were not accepted:
 - Wage and Hour Administration (-\$3.5 GF)
 - Mechanical Inspection (-\$52.8 GF and -\$3.8 Other)
 - Occupational Safety and Health (-\$27.9 GF and -\$26.5 Fed)
