BILL NO. HB 10

Analysis

This bill amends AS 11.71 to make possession of any amount of a schedule IA or IIA controlled substance a class C felony if a person has been previously convicted two or more times of misdemeanor drug possession. The bill also amends AS 12.55 to create a new substitution of judgment provision.

Passage of this bill is not expected to have a significant impact on the enforcement efforts of the Alaska State Troopers. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is being submitted.
