15	WHEREAS, Representatives Josephson and Hopkins introduced HB 82 and
16	Senator Kawasaki introduced SB 82, proposing to add to the powers and duties of the
17	Alaska State Commission for Human Rights and expressly prohibiting discrimination
18	based on sexual orientation or gender identity or expression; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, The Fairbanks North Star Borough is committed to a policy of
21	nondiscrimination, including sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, in
22	employment and in all of its services, programs, and activities and pursues the equal
23	treatment of all people it serves; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, The policies of a second class borough do not apply generally
26	within its jurisdiction, such as in matters of housing or private employment, and the
27	Borough does not have the authority to enact legislation addressing these concerns;
28	and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Providing for inclusion of all protected classes at the state level
31	will help eliminate and prevent discrimination and ensure that Borough residents
32	subjected to discrimination have recourse under law.

33	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the Fairbanks
34	North Star Borough urges the Alaska State Legislature to pass House Bill 82 and Senate
35	Bill 82.

38	distributed to the Alaska State Legislature.
