2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- Sec. 44.12.063. Katie John Day. Katie John Day is established on May 31 of
 each year to honor Ahtna Athabascan elder Katie John for her mentoring and
 advocacy in defense of Alaska Native customary and traditional hunting, fishing, and
 gathering rights. Katie John Day may be observed by suitable observances and
 exercises by civic groups and the public.
