A RESOLUTION

Proposing amendments to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to forward
funding of public education for grades kindergarten through 12.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Article IX, sec. 12, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:

Section 12. Budget. (a) The governor shall submit to the legislature, at a time fixed by law, a budget for the next fiscal year setting forth all proposed expenditures and anticipated income of all departments, offices, and agencies of the State. The governor, at the same time, shall submit a general appropriation bill to authorize the proposed expenditures, and a bill or bills covering recommendations in the budget for new or additional revenues.

* Sec. 2. Article IX, sec. 12, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) A budget submitted under (a) of this section shall include proposed expenditures to fund public education for grades kindergarten through twelve for the fiscal year following the fiscal year for which the budget is prepared. A general appropriation bill submitted by the governor and passed by the legislature shall

include an appropriation to public education for grades kindergarten through twelve for distribution in the fiscal year following the fiscal year for which the budget is prepared.

* Sec. 3. Article XV, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new section to read:

Section 30. Education Funding: Transition. (a) The 2020 amendment requiring forward funding of public education (art. IX, sec. 12(b)) takes effect thirty days after the lieutenant governor certifies that a majority of the votes cast on the proposition in the general election were in favor of the amendment unless, before certification, the legislature has failed to enact an appropriation bill to fund public education for grades kindergarten through twelve for fiscal year 2022.

(b) If the amendment does not take effect under (a) of this section, the amendment takes effect on the earlier of

(1) the date the legislature enacts an appropriation bill to fund public education for grades kindergarten through twelve for the fiscal year succeeding the fiscal year for which the budget is prepared; or

(2) January 1, 2026.

* Sec. 4. The amendments proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
