A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to national board certification for public school teachers."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 14.20.010 is amended by adding new subsections to read:
- 4 (b) A public school shall display in a prominent location the name of each teacher who teaches at that school who has achieved national board certification.
 - (c) It is the goal of the legislature that by the year 2025 at least four percent of public school teachers in the state will have achieved national board certification.
- 8 (d) In this section, "national board certification" means certification by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.
- * Sec. 2. AS 14.20.010(c) is repealed July 1, 2026.
