A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to national board certification for public school teachers."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 14.20.010 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

4 (b) A public school shall display in a prominent location the name of each
5 teacher who teaches at that school who has achieved national board certification.

6 (c) It is the goal of the legislature that by the year 2025 at least four percent of
7 public school teachers in the state will have achieved national board certification.

8 (d) In this section, "national board certification" means certification by the
9 National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.

10 * **Sec. 2.** AS 14.20.010(c) is repealed July 1, 2026.
