I appreciate your support of recreational venues and their desire to serve customers beer and wine.

Since the denial of license renewal, Taku Lanes has suffered a decline in customers and revenue leading up to summer where they generally see less customers anyway. Bowling alleys like Taku Lanes, that do not have restaurants as additional revenue sources, rely heavily on their seasonal leagues, open bowlers and beer and wine sales. Without beer and wine sales, their customer base drops a certain degree making paying the bills that much more difficult.

I have bowled in this house for 32 years and many more have bowled even longer. It has seen surges and declines but I do not know if the owners will be able to keep the house open without the revenue from the beer and wine sales.
