Explanation of Changes, Version M to Version U

House Bill 110:

Vehicle and Boat Transfer on Death Titles

In the House State Affairs Committee one amendment was adopted to HB 110 without objection.

The amendment added a new section to the bill, section 5, which allows customers to authorize the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to automatically change their mailing address to match the address used by the United States Postal Service (USPS).

Many individuals, when they move to another mailing address, change their address with the USPS but fail to do so at the DMV. The DMV receives a high volume of returned mail, and often has to send out multiple copies of the same document.

Allowing customers to have their mailing address automatically updated to match their address registered with the USPS promotes efficiency within the department and makes it easier for customers to update their address with the DMV.

The suggestion for this amendment came from within the department and they are supportive of the change.
