3 **** Section 1.** AS 15.20.081 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (m) An absentee ballot application must include an option for a qualified voter
5 to choose to receive absentee ballots by mail for future regularly scheduled state
6 elections. A voter who selects the option to receive future absentee ballots by mail
7 shall provide the division with the voter's electronic mail address, if any. At least 90
8 days before each state election, the division shall send to each voter who has requested
9 to receive future absentee ballots by mail, and who has provided the division with an
10 electronic mail address, notice by electronic mail indicating that the voter is scheduled
11 to receive an absentee ballot by mail for the election. A voter's selection of the option
12 to receive future absentee ballots by mail remains in effect, and the division may not
13 require a voter to reapply to receive absentee ballots by mail under this section, unless
14 the

15 (1) voter has not voted an absentee ballot for a period of four years; or

16 (2) voter's previous absentee ballot sent under this section was returned
17 to the division as undeliverable."

3 **"* Sec. 2.** AS 15.20.220 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (c) Before the certification of a state ballot counting review under
5 AS 15.15.450, the director shall select random voters in each house district who
6 submitted absentee ballots. The director shall attempt to contact the voter to confirm
7 that the voter returned an absentee ballot. On or before the day the director certifies a
8 state ballot counting review under AS 15.15.450, the director shall aggregate the
9 information collected under this subsection, deliver the information to the senate
10 secretary and the chief clerk of the house of representatives, and notify the legislature
11 that the information is available. The director shall include in the information
12 delivered under this subsection the number of absentee voters, by district, that

- 13 (1) the division attempted to contact;
14 (2) the division successfully contacted;
15 (3) reported voting by absentee ballot in the applicable election; and
16 (4) reported not voting by absentee ballot in the applicable election."

6 subsection upon the voter's written request. A voter may request that the division stop
7 sending absentee ballots at any time. If a voter does not request that the division stop
8 sending absentee ballots, the division may stop sending absentee ballots to the voter
9 and require the voter to reapply only if"
