Sectional Analysis House Bill 129

“An Act relating to fees charged to physically disabled state residents for hunting and fishing licenses and certain state park permits.”

Sections 1-2: conforming language.

Sec. 3: adds language providing for free hunting and fishing licenses for persons with disabilities.

Sec. 4-5: conforming language.

Sec. 6: makes it clear that despite the language of this bill a person must have a 70 percent disability to participate in computer assisted remote hunting.

Sec. 7: defines a “person with physical disabilities” to mean a person who presents written proof from a government agency that the person receives at least 50 percent disability compensation or an affidavit signed by a physician stating that the person is at least 50 percent disabled.

Sec. 8: adds language providing for a free annual state park campsite permit for disabled residents.

Sec. 9: defines a disabled resident as a state resident who presents written proof from a government agency that the person has received at least 50

percent disability compensation or an affidavit signed by a physician stating that the person is at least 50 percent disabled.
