A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to transportation of live crab."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.10.240 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.10.240. Transportation of <u>live crab</u> [LIVE CRAB]. (a) A person may not take out of <u>or</u> [,] ship, transport, or send from this state any <u>commercially</u> <u>taken</u> live King crab, species Paralithodes camtschatica, live Dungeness crab, species Cancer magister, or live Tanner crab, species Chionoecetes bairdi, <u>unless the crab</u> <u>have been landed in a port in the state and recorded on a fish ticket</u> [EXCEPT THAT ALL OF THESE SPECIES MAY BE SHIPPED LIVE VIA AIR FREIGHT AFTER PRE-PACKAGING].

(b) Notwithstanding (a) of this section, live Dungeness crab, species Cancer magister, may be taken, shipped, transported, or sent from the state by means of surface transportation <u>only</u> if the crab are taken at a time and location in the state for which the Department of Environmental Conservation does not require seafood processors to test Dungeness crab for the presence of marine toxins.
